Planning/Environmental Management

Renewable energy

Write a research report that investigates renewable energy options for Wairoa such as bioenergy, hydroelectricity, wind, marine (including multi-platform options) and solar power. The report will outline how much of the resource can be viably utilised given current technologies. Furthermore, the report will illustrate the economic potential including what is technically viable at sufficiently low cost. Lastly, the analysis will highlight relevant planning issues i.e. actual and potential environmental effects and make recommendations on how these can be addressed through district plan provisions. This report will provide a basis for section 32 reporting for the district plan review.



Planning/Environmental Management

Rural housing density

Write a research report that analyses the impacts of dwelling density controls verses no dwelling density controls on rural productivity and use of rural land. Currently the Wairoa District Plan has no controls on the number of dwellings that can be built on a rural property. However this can lead to unusual uses of small pieces of rural land adjacent to residential areas that are then used as makeshift camping grounds with a number of investors owning cabins, adversely affecting amenity values. As such Council would like to investigate the impact of restricting numbers of dwellings on rurally zoned property. However, Council does not wish to be overly restrictive or to adversely impact on the running of farming operations or papakāinga (cluster housing) developments within the district. This report will provide a basis for section 32 reporting

for the district plan review.

Review of the road naming policy, street numbering/addressing and road leglisation. Update of mapping and data systems, oversee the changing of signage.
