## Council's Response – Council's Activities

Council Activities are divided into two strategic goal areas being:

- Community Development & Participation  
*Council's aim is to provide services and facilities to encourage community participation, ensuring access to information and leisure opportunities and to promote the expansion of the economy by encouraging tourism options and business development.*
- Safe Living Environment  
*Council's aim is to provide services and facilities, which contribute to community health and safety and ensure that the natural and physical resources of the district are preserved for future generations.*

These are in turn supported by:

- Management Services
- Investments

Council has grouped its activities into 7 "Key Activity Groups" and the table on the following page shows how those grouped "key activity areas" relate to the activities of Council and shows where there is a direct linkage to the Community Outcomes identified in Part One of the LTCCP.

Part Two is divided into 7 Activity Group Areas and within each area the following information is provided:

1. A schedule of the activities within the Activity Group Area.
2. The community outcomes to which the activity primarily contributes and the ways in which the activity contributes towards the achievement of the outcomes.
3. Service Category details.
4. The proposed future levels of service.
5. Customer performance targets and measures.
  - a. Please note that Council will report annually on its achievement of performance targets and measures at the conclusion of each financial year. The base point for all performance targets and measures was concluded at the end of the 2006-07 financial year primarily based on the results of the Wairoa District Council Communitrak Survey and the New Zealand Census of Population and Dwellings.
  - b. The Wairoa District Council Communitrak Survey and the New Zealand Census of Population and Dwellings, in conjunction with Council's annual reporting of achievement of performance targets and measures, will continue to inform the assessment of such achievement or otherwise over the lifetime of this plan.
