The Wairoa District Council does not permit Camping or parking Campervans or Caravans on public land within the District for the purpose of overnight stays.

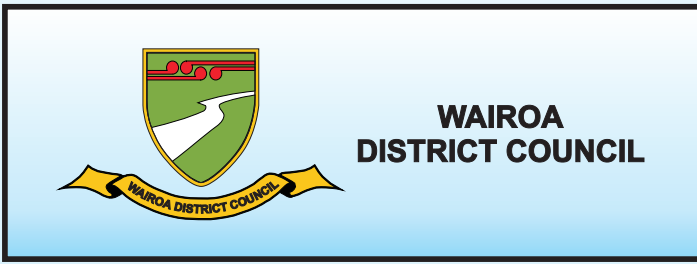
Kindly note therefore that if you wish to use this type of accommodation, it will be necessary to stay within one of the Camping Grounds/Holiday parks which are available within the District.
