The purpose of this Bylaw is to control freedom camping in the District in order to:

- a) Protect local authority areas;
- b) Protect the health and safety of people who may visit local authority areas; or
- c) Protect access to local authority areas.

1. INTRODUCTION

The Wairoa District Council makes this Bylaw under section 11 of the Freedom Camping Act 2011. This Bylaw should therefore be read alongside the Freedom Camping Act.

This Bylaw should also be read in conjunction with information provided by the Department of Conservation regarding Freedom Camping.

1.1 TITLE

This bylaw shall be known and cited as the Wairoa District Council Consolidated Bylaw Part 9 – Freedom Camping. For expediency this bylaw may be referred to as the Freedom Camping Bylaw.

1.2 PROCEDURE AND COMMENCEMENT

1.2.1 The initial resolution to make this Bylaw was passed by the Wairoa District Council at an ordinary meeting of the Council held on 9th September 2014 and was confirmed, following consideration of submissions received during the special consultative procedure, by a resolution at a subsequent meeting of the Council on 10th November 2015.

1.2.2 A revised version of the Bylaw was adopted on the 10 September 2019. The revised Bylaw comes into force on 1st November 2019.

1.3 DEFINITIONS

In this Bylaw, unless the context requires otherwise

TERM	DEFINITION
ACT	means the Freedom Camping Act 2011.
CAMPING GROUND	has the meaning given in section 5(3) of the Act.
COUNCIL	means the Wairoa District Council.
DISTRICT	means the district of the Council.
FREEDOM CAMP	has the meaning in section 5(1) and (2) of the Act.
LOCAL AUTHORITY AREA	has the meaning in section 6 of the Act.
SELF-CONTAINED VEHICLE	means a vehicle designed and build for the purpose of camping which has the capability of meeting the ablutionary and sanitary needs of the occupants of that vehicle for a minimum of three days without requiring any external services or discharging any waste and complies with the New Zealand Standard 5465:2001, as evidenced by the display of a current self-contained warrant issued under New Zealand Standard Self Containment of Motor Caravans and Caravans, NZS 5465:2001.

2. LOCAL AUTHORITY AREAS WHERE FREEDOM CAMPING PERMITTED

Freedom camping is permitted in any local authority area within the District unless it is restricted or prohibited:

- a) In accordance with this Bylaw; or
- b) Under any other enactment¹.

3. PROHIBITED AREAS AS OUTLINED IN SCHEDULE ONE

A person must not freedom camp in any prohibited area within the District, as identified in Schedule One: Prohibited Areas for Freedom Camping, without the prior written consent of the Council.

4. RESTRICTIONS ON FREEDOM CAMPING AS OUTLINED IN SCHEDULE TWO

A person may freedom camp in any area identified in Schedule Two: Restricted Areas for Freedom Camping, pursuant to the restrictions outlined below.

No person or persons may camp in an area identified in Schedule Two, unless

- a) They are in a self-contained vehicle, and
- b) They maintain and leave the site in a clean and tidy condition, and
- c) They do not light fires (open or in braziers), and
- d) They stay for a maximum of 3 nights, and
- e) All rubbish they generate is removed from the site for appropriate disposal.

5. PRIOR CONSENT FROM COUNCIL

5.1 Consent can be sought from the Council to allow freedom camping on a site listed in Schedule One: Prohibited Areas for Freedom Camping, which may be granted with or without conditions. Consent must be applied for in writing to the Council at least six weeks in advance of the date planned for freedom camping in the prohibited area.

5.2 Permission can be sought from the Council to waive or modify freedom camping restrictions on a site listed in Schedule Two: Restricted Areas for Freedom Camping, which may be granted with or without conditions. A waiver must be applied for in writing to the Council at least six weeks in advance of the date planned for freedom camping in the area without restrictions applying.

6. OFFENCES

As specified by section 20(1) of the Act, every person commits an offence who

- a) Freedom camps in a local authority area in breach of any prohibition or restriction in this Bylaw that applies to the area; or
- b) Makes preparations to freedom camp in a local authority area in breach of any prohibition or restriction in this Bylaw that applies to the area.

7. PENALTIES

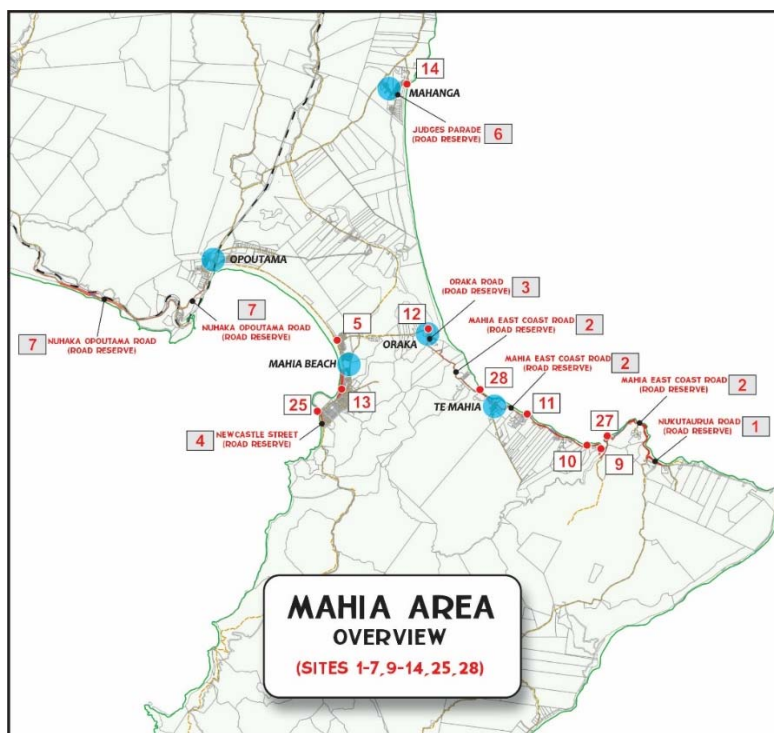
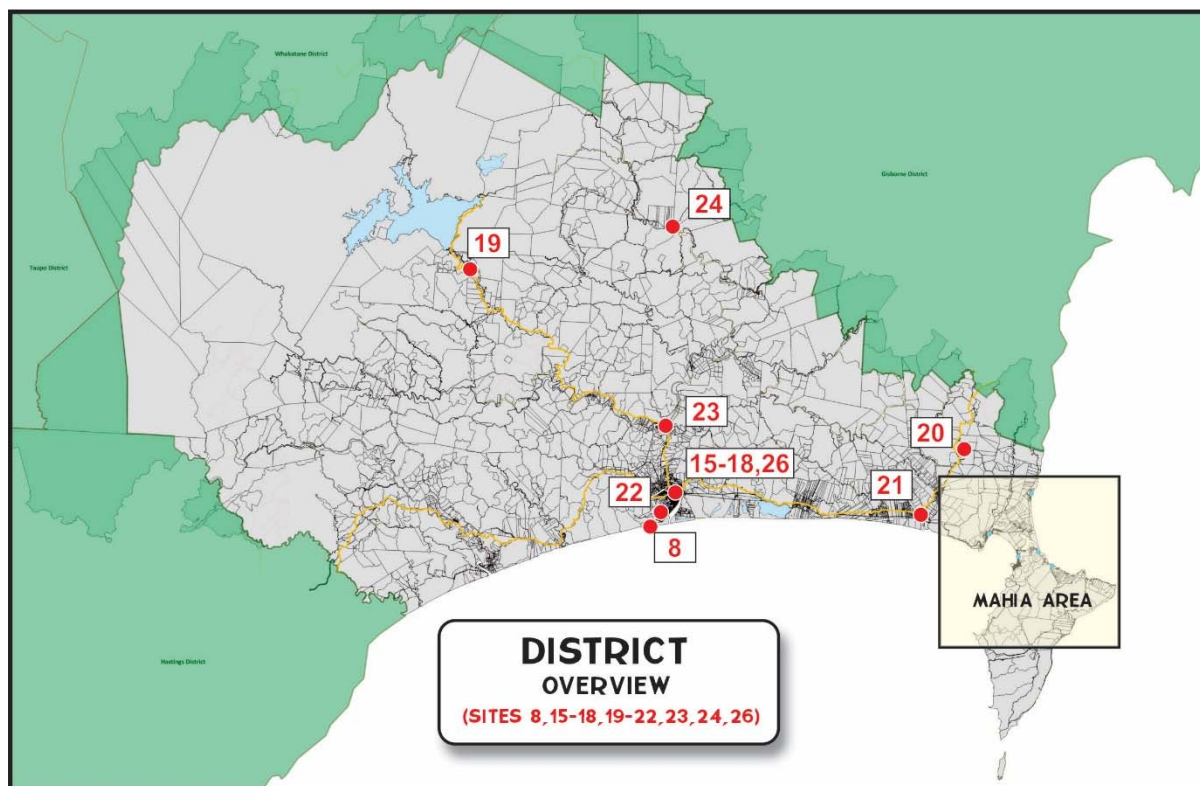
As specified by section 23(1) of the Act, every person who commits an offence pursuant to section 20(1)(a) and (c) of the Act is liable to a fine of \$200.

8. RELATIONSHIP OF BYLAW WITH RELEVANT SETTLEMENT LEGISLATION

This Bylaw does not limit or affect the rights in relation to iwi entitlements under the Ngāti Pāhauwera Treaty Claims Settlement Act 2012, Tūhoe Claims Settlement Act 2014, Te Urewera Act 2014, and Iwi and Hapū of Te Rohe o Te Wairoa Claims Settlement Act 2018.

SCHEDULE ONE: PROHIBITED AREAS FOR FREEDOM CAMPING

No camping of any kind may take place in the areas listed below in Schedule One.

SITE NO. 1

Nukutaurua Road - Road Reserve. This site has been identified as being historically sensitive being the location of previous battles, and containing places for the preparation of the dead for burial. As such camping in this area is considered inappropriate.



SITE NO. 2

Mahia East Coast - Road Reserve. This part of site 2 is commonly known as Auroa Point (The Crusher). Continuing on from site 1 and this part of site 2 is prohibited for the reasons noted for site 1.



SITE NO. 2, 9, 10, 27

Site 2. Mahia East Coast Road Reserve. The majority of this area as identified in red above must be kept clear to allow for people to access waahi kai areas and for recreational users of the reserve and as a safe play space for children.

Site 9. Whangawehi Reserve, Whangawehi Boat Ramp and Boat Park Area. This area should be kept clear to allow boats to be launched and retrieved, for the parking of trailers and for turning of long vehicles.

Site 10. Whangawehi 1B3H3 - Maori Reservation NZGZ 1995 p 326 (Urupa), Whangawehi 1B3H3 (Urupa). This land contains Urupa (burials) and it is considered inappropriate to allow camping in such sensitive areas.

Site 27. Whangawehi Coronation Reserve. Allow for people to access waahi kai areas and for recreational users of the reserve and as a safe play space for children.



SITE NO. 2, 11, 28

Site 2. Mahia East Coast Road Reserve. The majority of this area as identified in red above must be kept clear to allow for people to access waahi kai areas and for recreational users of the reserve and as a safe play space for children.

Site 11. Lot 11 DP 20317 Blk I Mahia SD-(Urupa), DP 20317 Blk II Mahia SD - (Esplanade Reserve) Urupa. This land contains Urupa (burials) and it is considered inappropriate to allow camping in such sensitive areas.

Site 28. Kaiuku (Esplanade) Reserve Lot 1 DP 24115 Local Purpose Reserve (Esplanade). Allow for people to access waahi kai areas and for recreational users of the reserve and as a safe play space for children.



SITE NO. 2, 3, 12

Site 2. Mahia East Coast Road Reserve. This part is not suitable for camping for road safety reasons.

Site 3. Oraka Road - Road Reserve. The majority of this area as identified in red above must be kept clear to allow for people to access waahi kai areas and for recreational users of the reserve.

Site 12. Lot 1 Deposited Plan 5387 – HBL1/528 – Oraka. The majority of this area as identified in red above must be kept clear to allow for people to access waahi kai areas and for recreational users of the reserve and as a safe play space for children.



SITE NO. 13

Local Purpose Reserve (Esplanade) NZGZ 1998 p 1533, Mokotahi Boat Ramp and playground, recreational precinct. This area must be kept clear to allow boats to be launched and retrieved, for the parking of trailers and for turning of long vehicles. And for the continued and extended use for recreational users of the reserve and as a safe play space for children.



SITE NO. 5

Ormond Drive Road Reserve, Ormond Drive and Moana Drive Intersection. This area may from time to time be used for the landing of rescue helicopters, and as such must be kept clear at all times.



SITE NO. 6, 14

Judges Parade Road Reserve and Lots 54 and 55 DP 127744 - Recreation Reserve, Mahanga (Boat / Carpark). This area should be kept clear to allow for parking of boat trailers and turning of long vehicles, and for recreational users of the reserve.



SITE NO. 4, 25

Site 4. Newcastle Street (Taylors Bay). To allow for the continued and extended use for recreational users of the reserve and day trippers. **Site 25.** Lot 3 DP 12487 Crown Land Reserved from Sale (Marginal Strip) Sec 58 Land Act 1948 and Part Section 45 Block V Mahanga SD Crown Land Reserved from Sale (Marginal Strip) Sec 58 Land Act 1948. To allow for the continued and extended use for recreational users of the reserve and day trippers.



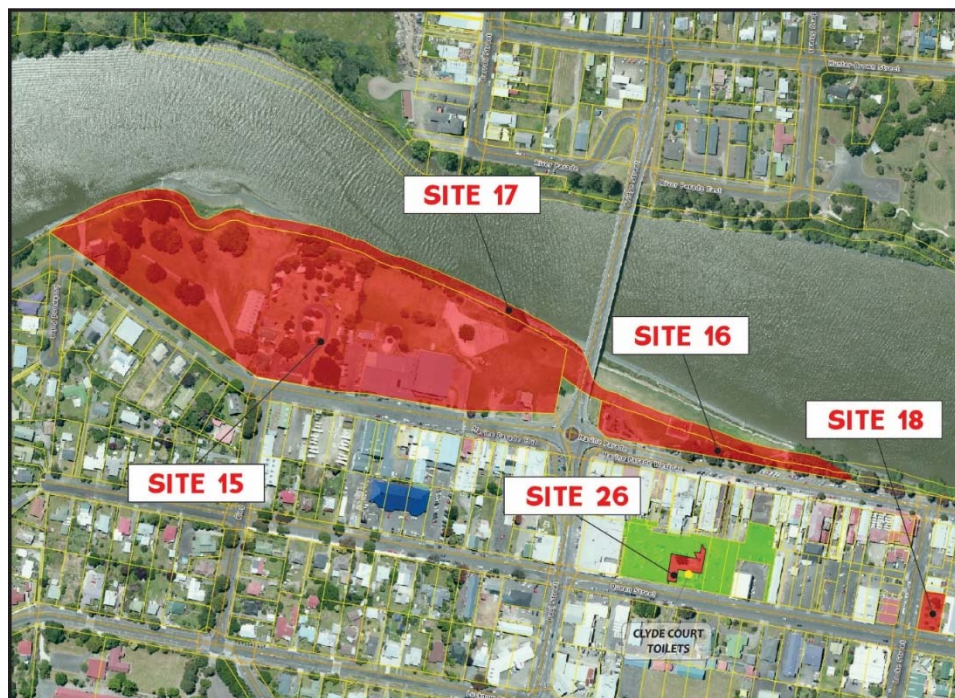
SITE NO. 7

Nuhaka – Opoutama Road – (Road Reserve). The majority of the area in red identified above needs to be kept clear for the continued and extended use for recreational users of the reserve, as well as for road safety reasons.



SITE NO. 8

Old Whakamahi Road – (Road Reserve). To allow for the continued and extended use for recreational users of the reserve and day trippers.



SITE NO. 15-18, 26

Section 1 Survey Office Plan 10489 - Local Purpose Reserve (Recreation & Community Facilities) NZGZ 1994 p 2422, TOWN Section 851 Clyde - Public Reserve, Part Section 9 Survey Office Plan 9425 - Local Purpose Reserve (Esplanade) NZGZ 1993 p 2691, Part Lot 1 DP 21920 - Public Amenities New Zealand Gazette 2000 p 3481.

Site 15. This area is a multi-use recreation space taken up with a sports centre and sport club buildings, leased camping ground, and boat launch area. This area is used for community events and as a safe play space for children.

Site 16. The area of this reserve shown on the above map is a safe play space for children and access to this site from road reserve is topographically difficult and could result in damage to vehicles and the reserve.

Site 17. Access to the identified areas shown in the above map of this reserve is blocked by site 15 and 16, and the proximity of the reserve to the river makes the ground soft, camping on such ground may damage vehicles and the reserve.

Site 18. This site contains a war memorial and is culturally and historically sensitive.

Site 26. This part of the site is a commercial area used for markets and is not appropriate for camping.



SITE NO. 19

Lot 76 Deposited Plan 7991 - Local Purpose Reserve (Esplanade), Tuai (Whakamarino Lodge Area). This area is a safe play space for children and area for day trippers.



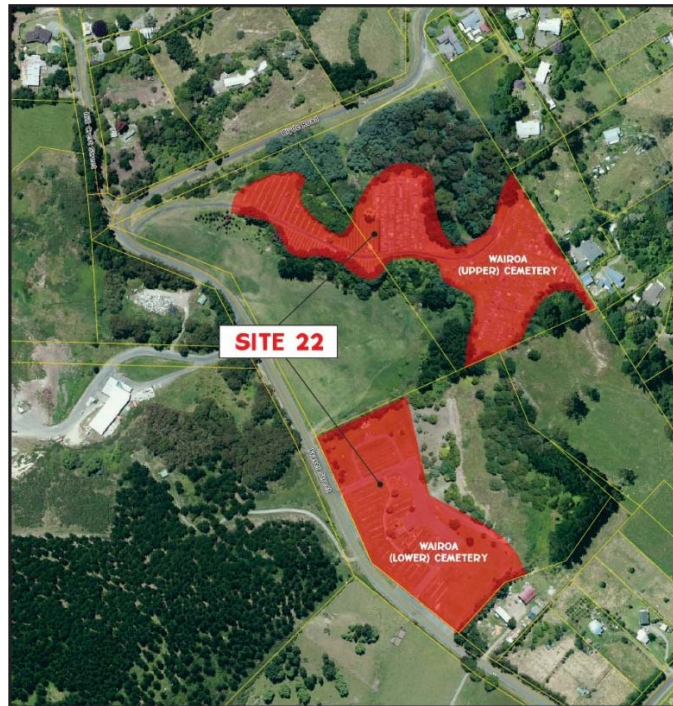
SITE NO. 20

Morere (Public) Cemetery - Section 81 BLK XV Nuhaka North SD - Cemetery Reserve NZGZ 1894 p 374. This site is a cemetery and camping is considered inappropriate in such a sensitive area.

Nuhaka (Public) Cemetery - Nuhaka 2E3C3 Block Maori Land Plan 773. This site is a cemetery and camping is considered inappropriate in such a sensitive area.



SITE NO. 22

Wairoa (Public) Cemetery - Lot 1 Deposited Plan 9351 Cemetery Reserve NZGZ 1878 p 1017. Lot 2 Deposited Plan 9351, Lot 1 Deposited Plan 14520. This site is a cemetery and camping is considered inappropriate in such a sensitive area.

Ruakituri (Public) Cemetery - Lot 1 Deposited Plan 9566 - Local Purpose Reserve (Cemetery). This site is a cemetery and camping is considered inappropriate in such a sensitive area.

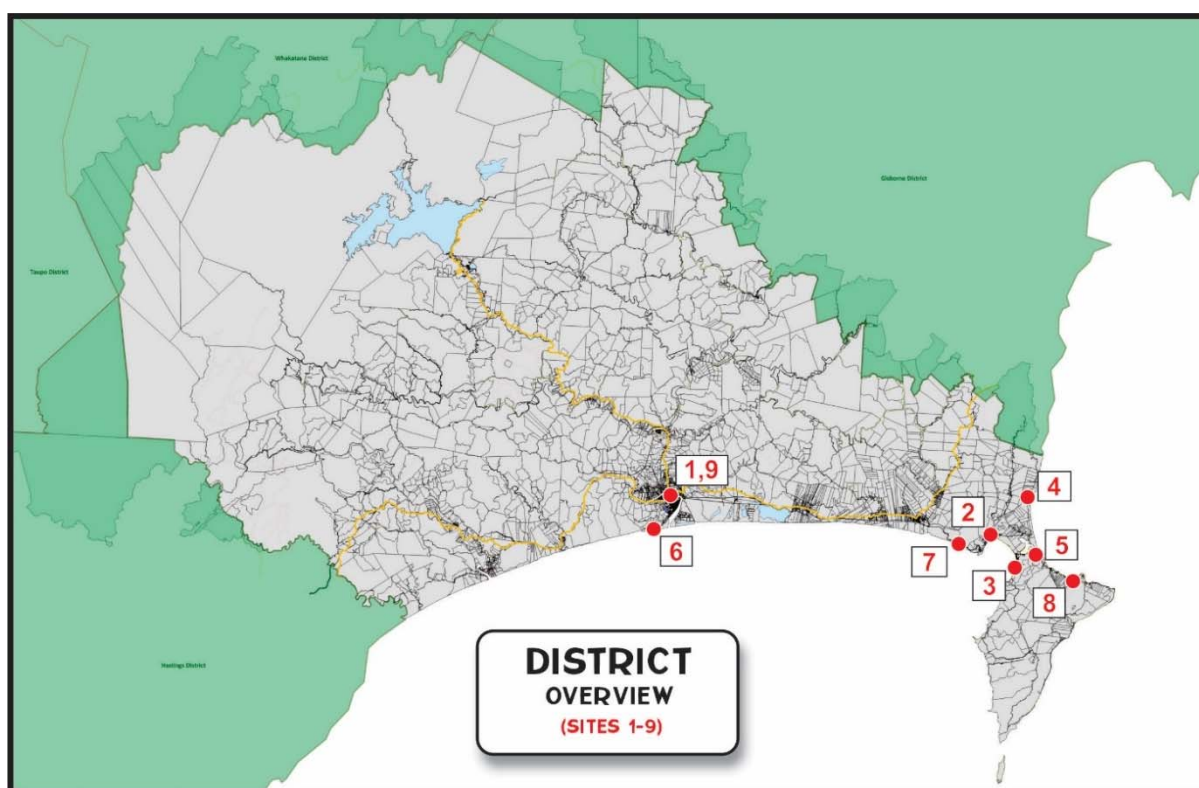
SCHEDULE TWO: RESTRICTED AREAS FOR FREEDOM CAMPING

LAND CONTROLLED BY THE WAIROA DISTRICT COUNCIL

Freedom camping may not take place on any land identified in Schedule 1.

In addition, freedom camping may not take place on any other land controlled by the Wairoa District Council unless:

- 1) It is undertaken in accordance with Section 4 of this bylaw, or
- 2) It is within 100m of a public toilet facility listed below and identified on the relevant maps in green, and
 - a. They do not light fires (open or in braziers), and
 - b. They stay for a maximum of 3 nights.

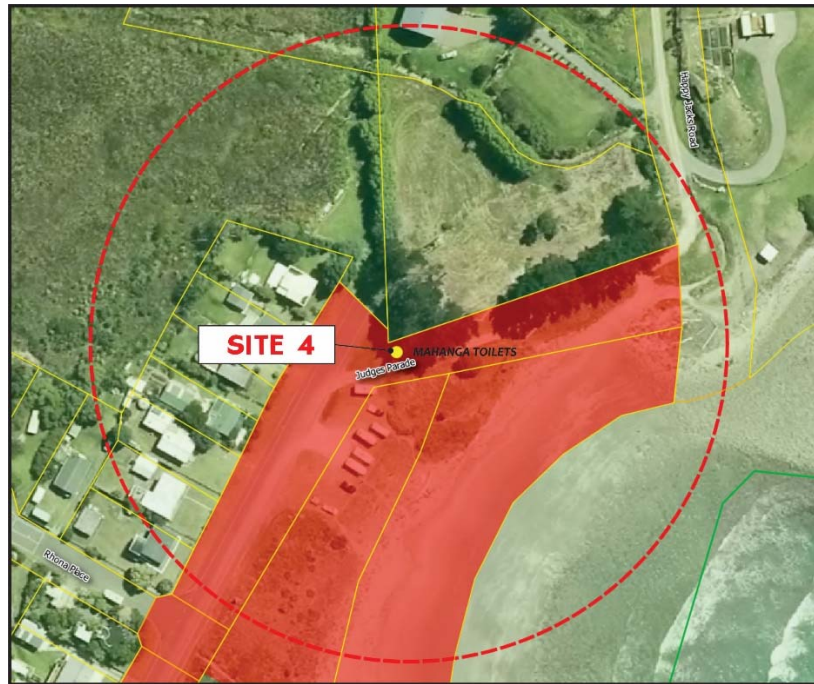

Judges Parade Road Reserve and Lot 54 DP 127744 - Recreation Reserve, Mahanga (Boat / Carpark).

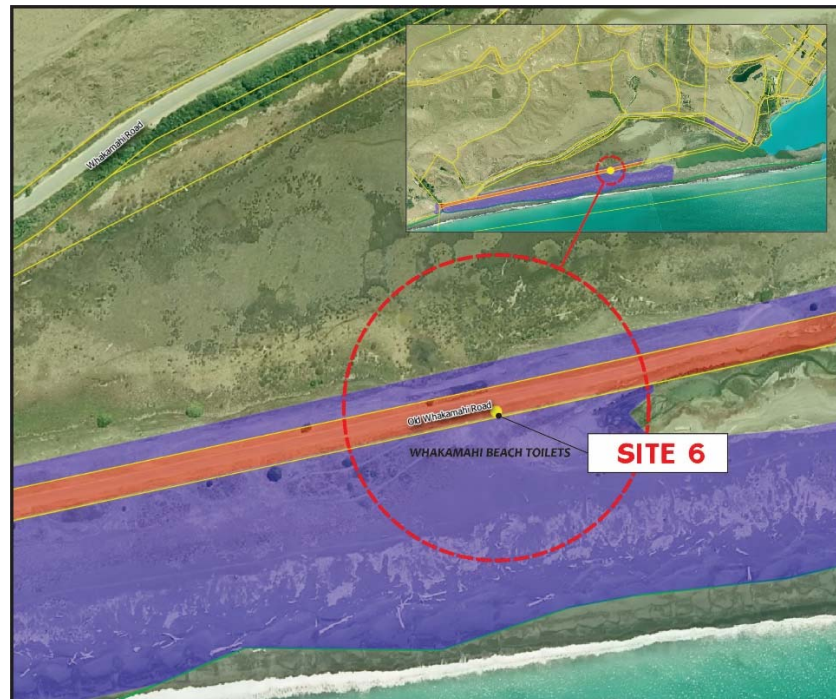

Lot 1 DP 5387 Blk V Mahanga SD

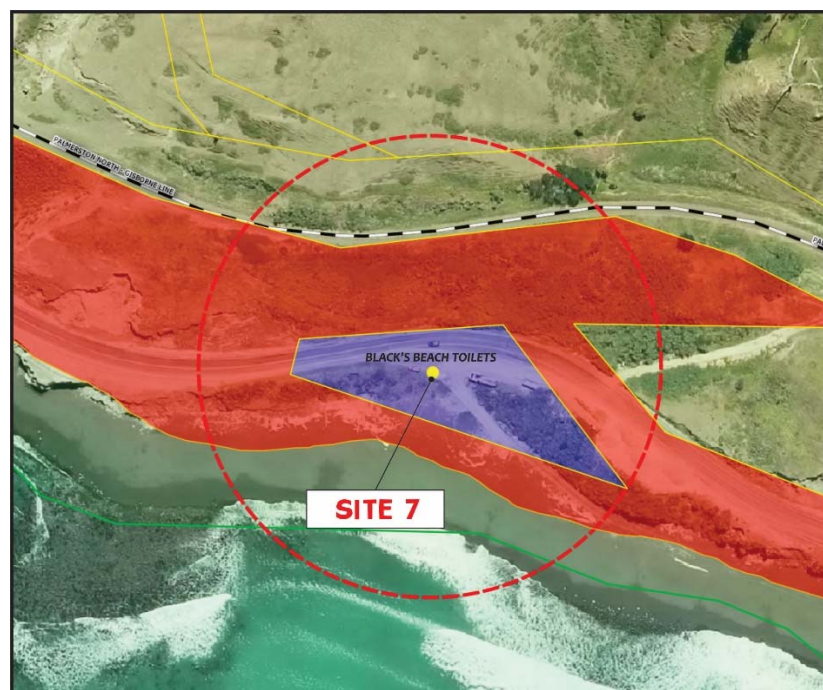

Old Whakamahi Road – (Road Reserve)

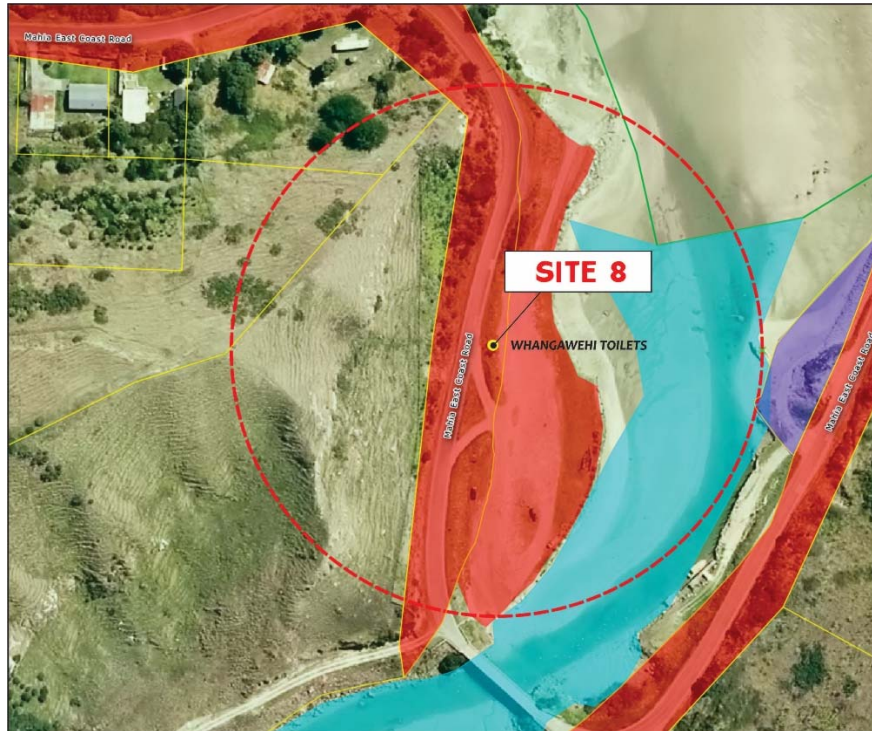
The area in red is identified as site 8 in the Schedule 1 to allow for the continued and extended use for recreational users of the reserve and day trippers.

The area in red is identified as site 7 in the Schedule 1. The majority of the area in red identified above needs to be kept clear for the continued and extended use for recreational users of the reserve, as well as for road safety reasons.



SITE 8 WHANGAWEHI

Mahia East Coast Road (Road Reserve). Whangawhehi Reserve.

The area in red is identified as site 2 and 9 in the Schedule 1. This area should be kept clear to allow boats to be launched and retrieved, for the parking of trailers and for turning of long vehicles, and to allow for people to access waahi kai areas and for recreational users of the reserve and as a safe play space for children.

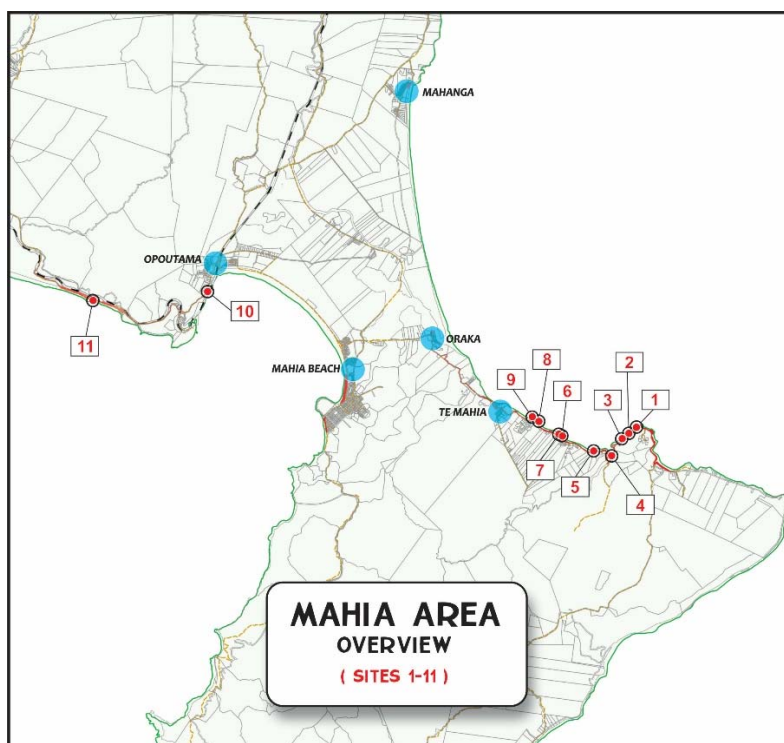

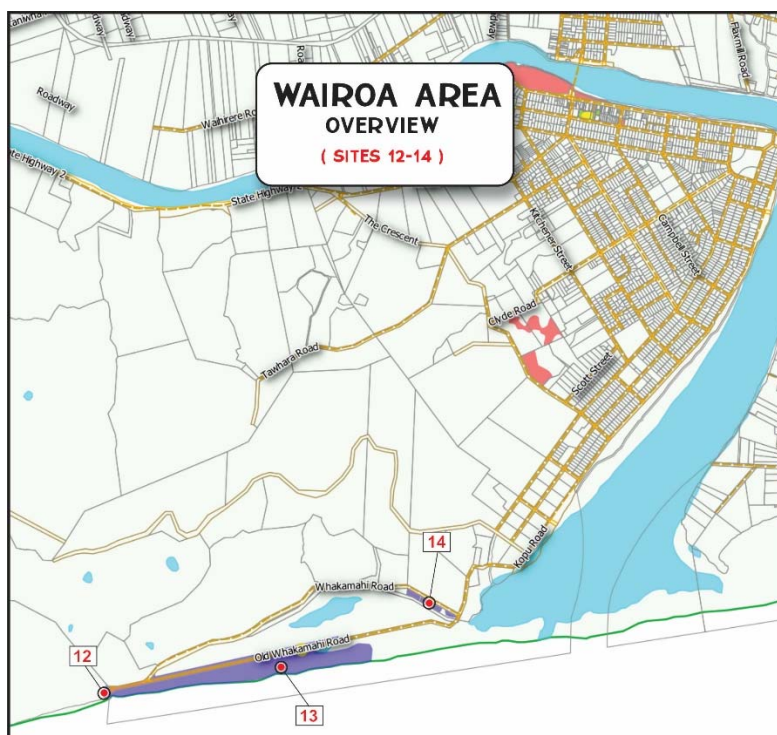
The area in red is identified as site 15, 16 and 17 in the Schedule 1. Site 15 is a multi-use recreation space taken up with a sports centre and sport club buildings, leased camping ground, and boat launch area. This area is also used for community events and as a safe play space for children. Site 16 is a safe play space for children and access to this site from road reserve is topographically difficult and could result in damage to vehicles and the reserve. Access to site 17 is blocked by site 15 and 16, and the proximity of the reserve to the river makes the ground soft, camping on such ground may damage vehicles and the reserve.

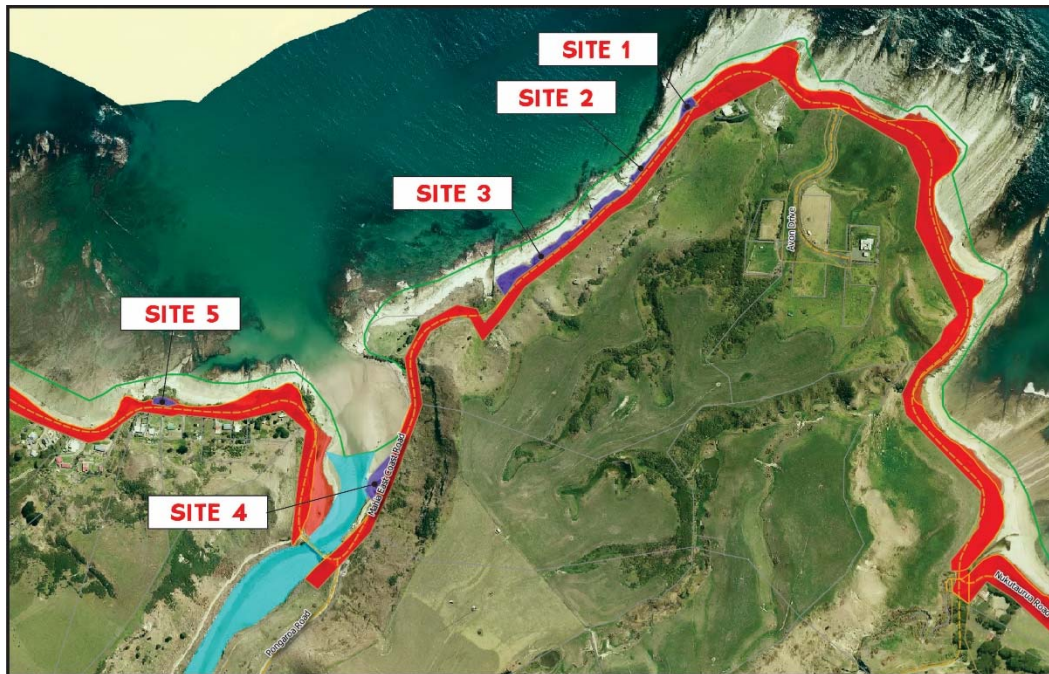

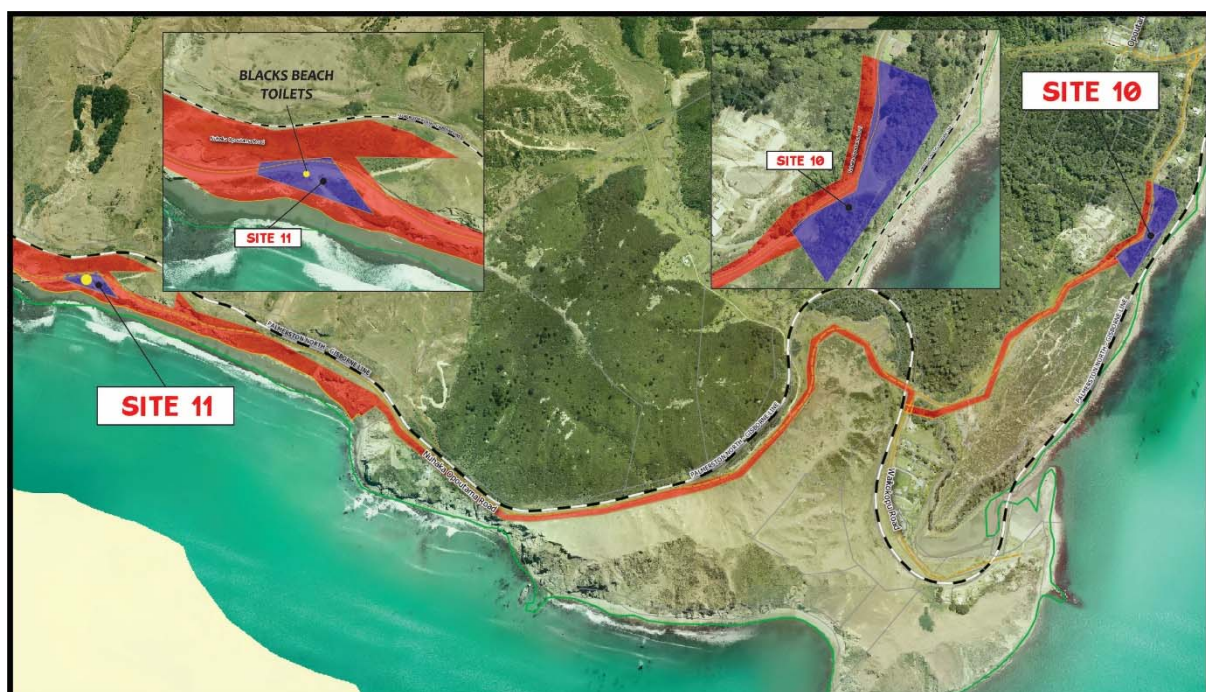

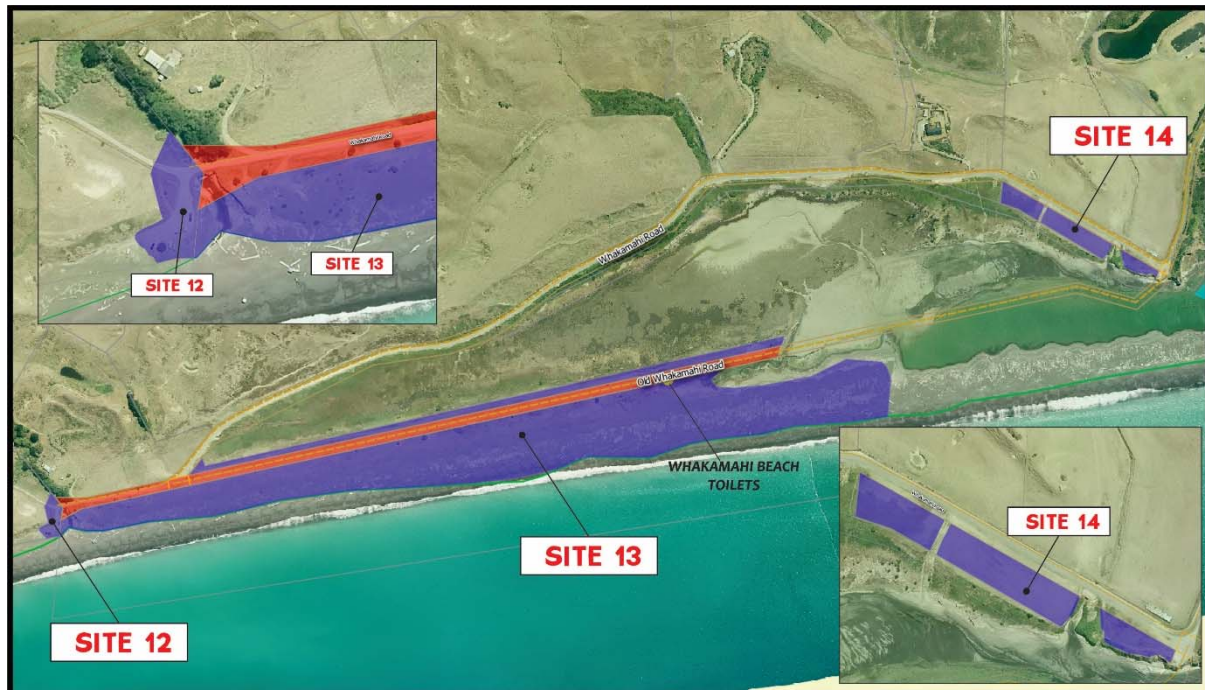
