### What is a menacing dog? *(under section 33, Dog Control Act 1996)*

Dogs can be classed as menacing from their breed or are reported to be posing a threat to people, stock and wildlife. There are also five types of dogs automatically classed as menacing - the Brazilian Fila, Dogo Argentino, Japanese Tosa, Perro de Presa Canario and Pit Bulls. A menacing dog must be on a lead and muzzled at all times when in public places to ensure the risk to the public is minimised.

### What is a dangerous dog? *(under section 31, Dog Control Act 1996)*

Dangerous dogs are considered high risk due to attacks or aggressive behaviour posing a serious threat to the community. There are no specific breeds classified as dangerous. Once designated, a dangerous dog must be kept in a securely fenced property, on a lead and muzzled in public, and must be neutered.
