

## SPECIAL LICENCE

No: 28/SP/133/2020

Sections 22, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, LAURA KELLY HOOPER is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at 46, Ruataniwha Road, Wairoa and known as "Wairoa A & P Showgrounds" to any person attending the following occasion or event:

### FUNDRAISING QUIZ NIGHT

The authority conferred by this licence shall be exercised by Laura Kelly Hooper being the person nominated by the licensee to manage the conduct of the sale and supply of alcohol pursuant to this licence

#### CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- a) Alcohol may be sold under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:  
**Saturday 31st October 2020**  
**6.00pm to 11.00pm.**
- b) The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the sale or supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
- i. Copies of the signage provided by Wairoa DLC must be prominently displayed at the point(s) of sale and supply.
- c) The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of this Act relating to the management of premises are observed:
- i. The licensee must ensure that Laura Hooper and any other persons involved in the sale or service of alcohol is fully conversant with the conditions of this licence and the provisions of the Act in respect of prohibited persons.
  - ii. A copy of this licence must be displayed at every point of sale and supply of alcohol
- d) Drinking water must be freely available, free of charge and prominently displayed at the following places for the duration of the event: at the bar.
- e) Food must be available for consumption on the premises as indicated on the application form, for the duration of the event
- f) Low alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises for the duration of the event.
- g) Non-alcohol beverages must be available for sale and supply on the premises for the duration of the event.
- h) The licensee must take the following steps to provide assistance with or information about alternative forms of transport from the premises:
- i. Notices advising of taxi services and the use of a telephone, shall be displayed at each point of sale
- i) That part of the premises for the consumption of alcohol is indicated on the plan date stamped as received by the Wairoa District Licensing Committee on 9th October 2020 and shall be Undesignated

Saturday 31st October 2020.
