#### Addressing the Future of North Clyde

Wairoa District Council has embarked on a study to look at the future of North Clyde, and to consider ways to address some of the challenges experienced in that part of town. Opus International Consultants have been engaged to assist with this study, which will ultimately include recommendations on positive steps that can be taken to improve the amenity and wellbeing of the people and environment of North Clyde.

The study includes an assessment of environmental performance of the main industries in North Clyde and draws on conversations with business operators and the residents of North Clyde to identify issues and aspirations for the area. The study will also involve the identification and assessment of potential management options (both Council and community-driven).

Opus is currently in the midst of conversations with the community, and held its first public Open Day on Tuesday 5 March 2013. There is a further opportunity for residents to have an input into the process at the next Open Day to be held on Tuesday 26 March 2013, at Te Ataarangi, 12 Carroll Street, North Clyde, from 3pm til 6pm. Residents are encouraged to come along and participate, and help make a positive contribution to the future of their neighbourhood.

As a resident of North Clyde, we want to know what it is that you believe defines your neighbourhood, and what your vision is for its future.




