Wairoa Christmas Market and Parade Road Closure Notice

Head to Wairoa's Marine Parade this Saturday for Christmas fun and festivities. With a morning market and entertainment from the Wairoa Library Green and the parade at lunchtime - the main street is the place to be.

The Christmas market will run from 9am to noon with face painting, kai and handcrafted gifts, paua dumplings, South African and Polynesian cuisine, chocolate strawberries, candyfloss, snow cones and cakes.

Grab your last-minute Christmas gifts from the gift stalls, which will feature jewellery, diving equipment, candles, soaps, gift packs and collectibles. Entertainment is high on the list, with circus performers, drummers, music, and dance.

This year's float parade theme is 'Kiwiana' with local businesses, organisations and schools working behind the scenes to put the finishing touches on their floats - plus the parade will include a special visit from Santa.

Please note that the Marine Parade will be closed to all traffic between Locke Street (at the intersection of the BNZ ATM) and Delhi Street (at the intersection next to Riverview Dairy) between 7am and 1.30pm.

At around midday, Marine Parade from the roundabout to Delhi Street will be closed for the parade, and SH2 at the roundabout will be closed for a short time to allow the parade convoy to travel through safely.
