#### **Local Authority Elections**

Local authority elections are a month away on Saturday, October 11.

Nominations for the Wairoa District Council election have seen 20 candidates throw their hats into the ring.

This week, voting documents will be delivered to those who have enrolled with delivery expected from Tuesday, 9 September, until Monday, 22 September. After the 7th October it is best to deliver your votes to the ballot bin available at the main Council office, Queen Street and New World Wairoa up to the close of voting 12noon Saturday, 11th October 2025.

People need to check their enrolment details to ensure they receive their voting papers at the correct address. If you are not enrolled, take action now by heading to the Electoral Commission New Zealand's website to enrol or update your details online.

Wairoa has four Mayoral candidates: Denise Eaglesome-Karekare, Camden Gaskin, Craig Little and Kurawari

There are nine nominations for the three General Ward seats. They are: Sara Bird, Amber Forrest, Camden Gaskin, Jeremy Harker, Stuart Harris, Sam Jackman, John Malis, Roz Thomas and Veronica Grace Tukaki.
